Cllr Roberts to report.</p> <p>The Oak tree has died again on the Recreation ground, Cllr Carnall advised that the Rec Centre are looking into this and will sort a replacement.</p> <p>Aubrey Salt – the street light has not been replace by our noticeboard which was removed when Western Power were replacing the poles, He has spoken to Western Power which said they would replace it but still not done – they did replace the one at the end of Salver Lane.</p> <p>Jayne Finney also advised that the one outside their property has also not been replace. PLANNING MATTERS	<p>Applications:</p> <p>SMD/2017/0571 – New Hill Farm, Tickhill Lane – Demolition and reinstatement of an agricultural building – NO OBJECTION subject to neighbours approval.</p> <p>SMD/2017/0534 – Mount Pleasant Farm, Windycote Lane – Proposed livestock building - OBJECTION – not appropriate in green belt not in keeping with the rural area, excessive in size, its location we understand is where an existing pond lies and therefore water drainage/table will be affected land is very water logged, new proposed access way onto main road is not appropriate.</p> <p>SMD/2017/0522 – Dilhorne Endowed C.E.(A) Primary School – Portable building to use as a classroom for the school – numbers up to 60 at moment – NO OBJECTION subject to neighbours approval it is temporary until know if numbers remain at the current level when more permanent building will be considered, and the portable building will be remove,</p> <p>Decisions: none</p> <p>Enforcement:</p> <p>Whympenny Farm – Cllrs Bateman and Carnall went to Hearing which took 4 hours, there was lots of interrogation from Whympenny's side.
