PUBLIC QUESTIONS	<p>Mr O'Brien had concerns about pavement safety in front of his property on High Street – vehicles go on pavement because of the vehicles parked on opposite side and the posts by the houses he considers that it is becoming dangerous. C Cllr Day said he would take a look when doing a Highways visit next week.</p> <p>Mr O'Brien was also interested in the current situation re Moss Feeds site, as far as the Parish Council were aware Moss's are about to resubmit an application and that their selling agent has not been approached by Ben Holloway re using the site for his business (VW campervan renovations) also Moss's would not be happy for any continued B2 use not being under their control as they still retain two residential properties adjacent to the site. The Parish Council had been in support of the previous application for houses on the site which had been withdrawn because the LPA wanted other information and the plans were being slightly amended.</p>

Deposit account – £8725.23 after transfer Transfer – £200.00</p> <p>2014/15 Precept: After attending the Precept Forum Clerk had contacted all Cllrs with details of how the precept works in relation to tax base etc with examples of what various figures would mean in relation to Council Tax and its bills. Cllrs had voted for which they would like to adopt and the majority when for the option of a £4000.00 precept figure. This means a Band D charge for 2014/15 of £21.51, which is a 46 pence decrease from 2013/4 figure and will show on the Council Tax bills as minus 2.13% reduction in our precept figure. The Council Tax Support Grant for Dilhorne is £200.99 which is passed on to the Parish Council by SMDC and therefore the actual amount received in 2014/15 will be £4200.99. Clerk has submitted the relevant form to SMDC confirming our requirement.</p>
